GENESIS COMPLETES INTERMODAL STUDY IN CENTRAL LOUISIANA

Through the Central Louisiana Economic Development Alliance (CLEDA), Genesis Consulting Group (and its teaming partner The RNO Group, LLC) was retained to perform an initial feasibility study or "high-level" Phase I reconnaissance study to determine whether the establishment of a multi-modal transportation connection (and associated distribution operations) in the Central Louisiana area is warranted. The basic aim of an "intermodal/multi-modal facility" or "inland port" is to provide more direct and more integrated methods of shipping and receiving products and raw materials from both truck and rail; to provide two-way shipping serving multiple customers with both modes; to make more shippers available to each customer; to make rail available to customers not located directly on rail; and to streamline shipping/receiving operations that enhance the services of existing customers and attract new customers to the area.

The Genesis Consulting Group team completed the conceptual study to help CLEDA and other stakeholders evaluate the feasibility, cost, obstacles, and benefits associated with creating such a logistical center. The study analyzed a broad range of topics (each focused on specific needs of the main industries existing in the area), but also incorporated features of other larger logistical centers and new trends in the movement of goods and products in the industry. The study completed in June of 2008 determined that the Region is capable of supporting these new transportation options. Genesis Consulting Group is now working with CLEDA on determining the "next steps" for moving the concept forward.
